

MVMA – Meridian Valley Maintenance Association Traffic Control

Rules and Regulations:

Obey traffic regulations in general including: stop for stop signs, limiting speed to 25 mph, and yield to pedestrians on all MVMA roads.

Penalties:

1. First Offense: Verbal (and/or written) reminder about the MVMA traffic policy issued by a Security Officer and/or Board of Trustee (preferably the Security Chairperson).
2. Second Offense: Twenty-five dollar fine per violation with written warning. Thirty days to pay fines. Late payments will incur a 1 1/2 % per month interest fee.
3. Repeat offenses and/or reckless, erratic, careless, negligent, aggressive, and/or disrespectful driving: Driver will not be allowed to drive on MVMA roads for 30 or more days. A legal injunction can be imposed resulting in an arrest if the injunction is violated.

Any person, invitee, guest or non-member may be barred from the use of MVMA roads should they violate the MVMA traffic rules.
