At Meridian Valley CC we have a long tradition of leaving the golf course better than we found it. When playing please take note of these items, and help us maintain fantastic course conditions year-round.

- · Observe cart signs when using riding power carts. Do NOT take any type of cart between bunkers and greens,
- . Keep up with the group in front of you. Allow faster groups to play through
- · Place rakes outside of bunker, parallel to play, after use.
- · Please fill all divots with sand and repair all ball marks.

Meridian Valley Country Club has adopted the following Local Rules to help govern play:

- ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE AND DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS: When a ball is believed to be lost, or hit out of bounds, should the player choose not to hit a provisional ball, they have a second option to drop a ball in a large area between the point where the ball is known or virtually certain to have come to rest or gone out of bounds and the edge of the fairway of the hole being played, with an additional 2 club-lengths, no closer to the hole. Penalty: 2 Strokes.
- RELIEF ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF RED PENALTY AREAS: Players have the option to take equidistant lateral relief on the opposite side of the Red penalty area as an extra relief option under Rule 17.1d.
- DROP ZONES: If a ball enters the penalty area on holes #6 and #8, the player must proceed under Rule 17.1b. The player can play it as it lies or as an extra drop option, take a one-stroke penalty to the drop zones, provided it is no neater to the hole than the point at which the original ball last crossed into the penalty area.
- BALL IN GENERAL AREA: A player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is: 1) within two club-lengths of the putting green, and 2) within two club-lengths of the ball. No Relief If Line of Play is Clearly Unreasonable.
- · MEASUREMENTS: All yardages are lasered to center of green.
